REBECCAS PRIVATE IDAHO (Aug 28th - 31st)

<u>Rebecca's Private Idaho</u> (RPI) is a gravel cycling race that takes place in Ketchum, Idaho and the surrounding backcountry every Labor Day weekend since 2013. The event is considered one of the world's largest and most celebrated gravel cycling races, and has been called a bucket-list event for both professional and amateur riders.

The girls will race on Sunday, August 31st. Rides and webinars will be scheduled throughout the summer to prepare the girls and mentors for an exceptional experience.
