



# REBECCA'S PRIVATE IDAHO x BE GOOD GIRLS MENTORSHIP PROGRAM

## WHAT IS IT?

The RPI - Be Good Girls Mentorship Program is an amazing opportunity for girls who want to ride [Rebecca's Private Idaho](#) and would like an experienced teammate/mentor to ride with them providing companionship, confidence, and insights.

The [Be Good Foundation](#) is partnering the [The Trailhead Bicycles](#) to create the RPI - Be Good Mentorship program, matching 12-18 yr old girls with experienced female mentors that will ride RPI alongside each girl.

The program will provide live webinars with Rebecca, mentors, and mentees to review courses, talk about training, nutrition, bike set up questions, weather, clothing, and more. There will be at least one group ride before the race to preview some of the course with mentees, mentors, and Rebecca. All girls will receive registration, event t-shirts, nutrition & gear support, training tips, community, and connection!

## WHO IS THIS FOR?

The program is for girls ages 12-18 yrs who have some cycling experience such as Idaho Interscholastic Cycling League participation. Applicants must be willing to train for the event and set a target of completing their selected course distance. **All interested girls must complete the [application](#).** Up to 10 girls will be chosen for the mentorship program.

**MENTORS** will be hand selected by Aerah Hardin, the Be Good Executive Director, and Erin Solomon, co-owner The Trailhead Bicycles. Both Aerah and Erin are local Wood River Valley residents and are active members of our local cycling community. Mentors will all be experienced cyclists with a passion for adventure, racing, and coaching. Mentors will be available to their mentees for a minimum of 1 group ride or meet up prior to the event and will ride with their mentee from start to finish on event day.

# WHEN AND WHERE

## REBECCAS PRIVATE IDAHO (Aug 29th -Sept.1st, 2024)

[Rebecca's Private Idaho](#) (RPI) is a gravel cycling race that takes place in Ketchum, Idaho and the surrounding backcountry every Labor Day weekend since 2013. The event is considered one of the world's largest and most celebrated gravel cycling races, and has been called a bucket-list event for both professional and amateur riders.

The girls will race on Sunday, September 1st, 2024. Rides and webinars will be scheduled throughout the summer to prepare the girls and mentors for an exceptional experience.
